### List of Frequently Asked Questions for B.Ed. Programme

**What is the method of the conduct of B.Ed. Entrance Examination, 2020 – Offline using Pen/Paper or Online?**

The procedure of the conduct of B.Ed. Admission will be Online, during the session: 2020-21. Further details about the method of conduct of B.Ed. Entrance Examination will be uploaded on the website of University of Delhi soon. Please check the PG Admissions portal of the University and Department of Education (<http://doe.du.ac.in/>) regularly.

**What is the schedule of B.Ed. Entrance Examination?**

The schedule of B.Ed. Entrance Examination will soon be uploaded on the website of University of Delhi, along with other Post-Graduate (PG) programmes. Please check the PG Admissions portal of the University and Department of Education (<http://doe.du.ac.in/>) regularly.

**I am a final-year student of a renowned University. But my final semester examination could not be held owing to national lockdown due to Coronavirus Pandemic. Am I still eligible to apply for B.Ed. Course this year?**

You are eligible to apply for B.Ed. Programme this year online and may be provided 'provisional' admission to the course. However, your admission to B.Ed. Programme will be *confirmed only* after submission of final year marksheet, with evidence of minimum eligibility conditions being fulfilled.

**What is the eligibility requirement to pursue B.Ed. Course from University of Delhi?**

**Are the students who do not have a domicile in Delhi-NCR region eligible to apply for B.Ed. Programme at University of Delhi?**

Those students/ candidates, who do not have a domicile in Delhi-NCR region, are eligible to apply for B.Ed. Programme at University of Delhi. You will be expected to submit Migration certificate, Transfer certificate and other relevant documents from the previous educational institution, during the time of admission, as mentioned in B.Ed. e-Prospectus/ Information Bulletin.

**How can I apply for multiple courses?**

In order to apply for multiple courses at University of Delhi, please go through the following steps:

1. Register yourself and then login in the PG portal of Delhi University. You have to fill in the necessary details after login.
2. On the homepage of your profile, “Apply Online” option will be available. Click on it.
3. After filling one form, you can again click on “apply online” for another course.
4. Fees of each course will be paid separately.

**I have secured less than 50% marks in my graduation and belong to a reserved category? Am I eligible for B.Ed.?**

For eligibility conditions and relaxations under different quota, kindly refer to the PG Bulletin of B.Ed. Programme.

**Can I get the job after completing B.Ed.?**

After completing B.Ed. program one can apply for either government or private jobs. But completion of B.Ed. programme does not assure job. Please refer to the PG Bulletin for more details.

**Is the B.Ed. programme in Delhi University annual or semester mode?**

In Delhi University the B.Ed. programme is in annual mode.

**Is there an opportunity to correct Application Form?**

Regarding corrections in the application form, please contact the Help Desk/ Grievance Redressal available at the University website.

**Is there a single form for B.Ed. and B.Ed. special education?**

B.Ed., B.Ed. special education, are different programs and you have to apply separately and their entrance tests will also be separate. The admission schedule as well as steps to fill forms are available at the website of Delhi University

**I am B.Com. (Pass) / B.A (Pass) / B.Sc. (Pass) graduate can I apply for Commerce, Sociology, Psychology as a pedagogy subject?**

No, the candidate needs to be postgraduate in Commerce/Sociology/Psychology to apply as a pedagogy subject. Kindly read the prospectus for more detail information.

**I am Home Science graduate in which colleges can I apply for B.Ed. programme?**

Home Science will be offered only at Lady Irwin College only for women candidates where B.Sc. (Home Science) / M.Sc. (Home Science) / B.H.Sc. is the only eligibility degree.

**What will the medium of instructions for B.Ed. programme?**

The medium of Instructions will be Hindi or English for B.Ed. programme
