**Syllabus of the Entrance Test for the programme B. Ed. Special Education
(Visual Impairment) of the Department**

About the Entrance Test

All the candidates are required to appear in the entrance test. The test will consist of 100 questions. Each question would carry FOUR marks. As such, maximum marks would be 400. There is **NEGATIVE MARKING**. For each wrong answer **ONE mark would be deducted**.

Structure of the Entrance Test

Description of the Content of the Test:-

- **Reasoning and General Awareness** This would include areas to assess abilities such as reasoning (mathematical, inductive and deductive), identifying and understanding the relationship among various elements, decision making, data analysis, interpretation etc. This section will also assess the awareness and knowledge of the candidate in the field of education, national and international affairs, etc.
- **Language Comprehension:** The Comprehension Test aims at assessing the candidate's language comprehension skills both in English and in Hindi upto 10+2 level.
- **Subject Knowledge upto 10th Standard :** This component will assess the content knowledge and analytical abilities of the candidates in the core subjects studied up to 10th standard.
