For each correct answer, a student shall score +4 marks and for each wrong answer, there will be -1 mark. No mark shall be given for a question notattempted. <br> - The Entrance Test shall be bilingual (English and Hindi) whereverapplicable. <br> - There will be no descriptive questions. |
