## INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING IN THE INTERVIEW FOR ADMISSION TO M.Phil. PROGRAMME

- The M.Phil. Interview is planned for **two days**, i.e., **January 27<sup>th</sup> and 28<sup>th</sup>**, **2021** (Wednesday and Thursday).
- Based on the information on UGC-NET (in Education) results and research proposal updated by the candidates on the University Admission Portal, the interview schedule for all eligible candidates is also being displayed at the Department's website (<u>http://doe.du.ac.in</u>) on 26<sup>th</sup> January (morning).
- This year, each candidate has to appear in **One Interview in an ONLINE mode**.
- Candidates are **not required** to report at the Department of Education.
- The interviews are scheduled from **10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.**
- Candidates are advised to be ready with a suitable device (Smartphone/Laptop/Desktop with webcam & headphone) and good connectivity at their end on the day of their online interview at Google Meet Platform.
- All candidates are expected to be available online by 9:50 A.M. on the day of their interview using the Google Meet link. The link will be sent to each candidate on 26<sup>th</sup> January (evening). Candidates have been placed in different Boards.
- The Google Meet link will be provided on 26<sup>th</sup> January (evening) on each candidate's Email as registered in their online application form.
- There will be a Technical Team located at the Department to facilitate the interviews on all the days. In case any eligible candidate does not get the link, he/she should communicate the Admission Committee immediately through Whatsapp / SMS message only @ 9312282536.
- All Candidates must join the Google Meet using the link for attendance at 10:00 A.M. The candidates will be required to switch on their cameras and present themselves holding any bonafide photo identity card (Aadhar/ DL/ Voter Id/ PAN card/ Passport/ Bank Pass-Book with Photo/ Ration Card/ Student Identity Card or any other appropriate Identity card) so that the Interview Board could verify the identity of the candidate. After taking the attendance, the Interview Board would ask all the candidates to leave the online meeting room by 10:10. A.M. and rejoin again once they are asked to do so.

- The interviews will then start from **10:15 A.M.** onwards and candidates will be communicated to rejoin the meeting room one by one.
- The Technical Team of the Department will monitor the **entry** and **exit** of each candidate as per the Attendance list. No candidate should try to join Google Meet during the interview of other candidates. Any such violation would lead to disqualification of the candidature.
- Any recording of the interview process by the candidate is strictly prohibited.
- Attempt of impersonification or any other malpractice would lead to disqualification of the candidature.
- All candidates are required to keep their cameras on during the entire duration of their interview. It is expected that there is no other person or any disturbance near the candidate.
- No Candidate is required to make any Power Point Presentation for the interview.
- Each candidate is expected to introduce himself/herself and talk about his/her research proposal for **5-7 minutes** at the beginning of the interview. Candidates are expected to exhibit competence for undertaking research and show clarity in their conceptual and research base/ ideas.
- After completion of the interview, the candidate should leave the meeting and not try to join again.
- The Department's Technical Team will monitor the entry and exit of each candidate as per the order of candidates in the attendance list. The Technical Team would communicate each candidate to join the Google Meet as per the order in the list. Candidates are expected to attend the SMS/WhatsApp message on the contact number mentioned in their online application form.
- If the candidate is not able to join Google Meet, he/she should communicate the Admission Committee immediately through Whatsapp/SMS message @ 9312282536. Don't panic in any case. You may write your concern on the email ciephdadmissions2020@gmail.com.
- Candidates who do not turn up for the interview would be marked Absent.
- Candidates who do not appear for the interview will get disqualified.
- Keep visiting the website (<u>http://doe.du.ac.in</u>) regularly for updates.
- The Department is looking forward to scholars who have the potential to contribute meaningfully to research in Education.
