**INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES APPEARING IN THE INTERVIEW
FOR ADMISSION TO Ph.D. PROGRAMME**

- The Ph.D. interviews are scheduled on **three days**, i.e., **January 18th, 19th and 20th**, 2021 (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday).
- This year, each candidate has to appear in **One Interview in ONLINE mode**.
- Candidates are not required to report at the Department of Education.
- The interviews are scheduled from **10:00 A.M. to 2:00 P.M.**
- *Candidates are advised to be ready with a suitable device (Smartphone/Laptop/Desktop with webcam & headphone) and good connectivity at their end on the day of their online interview at **Google Meet Platform**.*
- Based on the information on UGC-NET (in Education) results and research proposal updated by the candidates on the University Admission Portal, an **interview schedule for all eligible candidates will be displayed at the Department's website (<http://doe.du.ac.in>) by 17th January (Sunday) morning.**
- All candidates are expected to be available online by **9:50 A.M.** on the day of their interview using the **Google Meet link**.
- **The Google Meet link** will be provided on the candidate's **Email on 17th January**.
- There will be a Technical Team located at the Department to facilitate the interviews on all the days.
- **All Candidates must join the Google Meet using the link for attendance at 10:00 A.M.** The candidates will be required to switch on their cameras and show themselves holding any **bonafide photo identity card** (Aadhar/ DL/ Voter Id/ PAN card/ Passport/ Bank Pass-Book with Photo/ Ration Card/ Student Identity Card or any other appropriate Identity card) in their hand so that **Interview Board** could verify the identity of the candidate. The Department shall be taking a screenshot of each candidate at different points of time during the interview for record purposes. The Interview Board would then ask all the candidates who are present in the meeting to leave the meeting by **10:10. A.M.** after attendance.
- The interviews will start from **10:15 A.M.** onwards in different Boards.

- The Technical Team of the Department will allow the **entry** and **exit** of each candidate as per the Attendance list. No candidate should try to join Google Meet during the interview process of other candidates. Any such violation would lead to disqualification of the candidature.
- Any recording of the interview process by the candidate is strictly prohibited.
- Attempt of impersonification or any other malpractice would lead to disqualification of the candidature.
- **No Candidate is required to make any Power Point Presentation for the interview.**
- **All candidates are required to keep their cameras on during the entire duration of their interview.** It is expected that there is no other person or any disturbance near the candidate.
- Each candidate is expected to introduce himself/herself and talk about his/her research proposal for **5-7 minutes** at the beginning of the interview. Candidates are expected to exhibit competence for undertaking research and show clarity in their conceptual and research base/ ideas.
- After completion of the interview, the candidate should leave the meeting and not try to join again.
- The Department's Technical Team will monitor the entry and exit of each candidate as per the order given in the interview list. The Technical Team would communicate each candidate to join the Google Meet as per the order in the interview list. Candidates are expected to attend the SMS/WhatsApp message on the contact number mentioned in their online application form.
- If the candidate is not able to join Google Meet, he/she should communicate the Admission Committee immediately through Whatsapp/SMS message @ 9312282536. Don't panic in any case. You may write your concern on the email ciephdadmissions2020@gmail.com.
- Candidates who do not turn up for the interview would be marked **Absent**.
- **Candidates who do not appear for the interview as per schedule will get disqualified.**
- **Keep visiting the website (<http://doe.du.ac.in>) regularly for updates.**
