

Basis of Admission:

The selection of candidates for admission to B.Ed (Special Education -Visually Impaired) will be made on the basis of merit in the entrance examination to be conducted in consultation with the Dean, Faculty of Education, University of Delhi.

About the Entrance Test:

All the candidates are required to appear in the entrance test. The test will consist of 100 questions. Each question would carry FOUR marks. As such, maximum marks would be 400. There is **NEGATIVE MARKING**. For each wrong answer ONE mark would be deducted.

Description of the content of the test:

- **Reasoning and General Awareness:** This would include areas to assess abilities such as reasoning (mathematical, inductive and deductive), identifying and understanding the relationship among various elements, decision making, data analysis, interpretation etc. This section will also assess the awareness and knowledge of the candidate in the fields of the education, national and international affairs, etc.
- **Language Comprehension:** The Comprehension Test aims at assessing the candidate's language comprehension Skills both in English & in Hindi up to 10+2 level.
- **Subject knowledge up to 10th standard:** This component will assess the content knowledge and analytical abilities of the candidates in the core subjects studied in 10th standard.
