CONCEPT NOTE

The curriculum of B.Ed. and M.Ed. in many universities and other institutions of teacher education tend to provide in-depth exposure to the students of Education. This exposure contains numerous aspect of theories and perspectives related to various issues of concerned subjects (Social Science Pedagogy and Human Rights Education etc.). This is often found that in these subjects there is immense scarcity of adequate literature in Hindi language, which is used as medium of instruction by the considerable number of students. With the changing nature and duration of the B.Ed. Course from one year to two years' teacher development programme, we find greater opportunity to have in depth deliberation and discussion on various aspects related to Philosophical, Methodological, Conceptual and Curricular dimensions of various subjects. The paucity of both theoretical and empirical literature in Hindi language create intellectual barrier to all those teachers, researchers and students, who have Hindi as medium of teaching and learning. Such students often remain deprived from participation in the discussion and deliberation. Furthermore, they do not receive adequate exposure to the conceptual and theoretical complexity of any of the given concepts. In such situation the researcher and students with the medium other than English language are often ghettoized into an indifferent group which feels somewhat disconnected whatever is being discussed in the class. These researchers and students often feel difficult to produce quality research papers and other kinds of assignment simply because they do not get reasonably appropriate material in their own language to study. In the light of above scenario of educational institutions, it seems most appropriate task to conceptualized a conference on content development in the following areas of Social Science Pedagogy and Human Rights Education.

1. The Areas of Pedagogy of Social Science (सामाजिक विज्ञान शिक्षण के क्षेत्र)
 - a. Trajectory of Social Science Evolutionary Process: Philosophical and Theoretical discourses (सामाजिक विज्ञान का प्रक्षेपवक्र (Trajectory), व्योत्पत्तिमूलक विकास, सैद्धांतिक और दार्शनिक विमर्श)
 - b. Cross Cultural perspectives and issues in social science (विविध सांस्कृतिक परिपेक्ष्य एवं सामाजिक विज्ञान शिक्षण के मुद्दे)
 - c. General Approaches in the construction of social science curriculum: thematic organization, Interdisciplinary, multi-disciplinary and fused frameworks (सामाजिक विज्ञान की पाठ्यचर्या की संरचना की सामान्य विधियाँ: विषयगत आधारित संयोजन, अंतरअनुशासनिक, बहुअनुशासनिक और एकीकृत ढांचे)
 - d. Researches in social sciences: challenges and issues related to theoretical and methodological sphere. (सामाजिक विज्ञान में शोध, चुनौतियाँ और सरोकार, सैद्धांतिक एवं पद्धतिगत क्षेत्रों से जुड़े मुद्दे)
2. Human Rights Education (मानवाधिकार शिक्षण)
 - a. Introduction to Rights, Human Rights and Human Rights Education with reference to Philosophical, Psychological, Political, and Sociological perspective. (मानवाधिकार एवं मानवअधिकार शिक्षण का दार्शनिक, मनोवैज्ञानिक, राजनैतिक और समाजशास्त्रीय संदर्भों में परिचय)
 - b. Approaches to Human Rights: western political liberalism, socialism and social welfare principles, cross-cultural rights traditions, and the UN instrument. (मानव अधिकारों को समझने के परिपेक्ष्य एवं विधियाँ: पश्चिमी राजनैतिक उदारवादी परिपेक्ष्य एवं विधि, सामाजवाद एवं सामाजिक कल्याण के सिद्धान्त का परिपेक्ष्य, विविध सांस्कृतिक अधिकारों की परंपरा का परिपेक्ष्य और सयुक्त राष्ट्र संघ की घोषणाओं एवं प्रस्तावों से संबन्धित परिपेक्ष्य)
